



Zoom Zoom Zoom



Designed to stand out in a crowd, the 161 foot, aluminum, tri-deck *Zoom Zoom Zoom* will turn heads in any anchorage. Her sleek styling and curvacious exterior are a mere hint of the elegance to be found inside.





The outside spaces on *Zoom Zoom Zoom* offer myriad options for relaxation and entertainment.

The aft swim platform is spacious enough to access all of the water toys easily. You can even throw a "beach party" on it!

The main aft deck boasts a large dining table that seats ten. Aft on the pilot house deck there are three separate seating areas where you can enjoy cocktails under the stars. A round dining table here, which also seats ten, is tucked under a protective overhead.

The sundeck features yet another large dining area, as well as a bar, barbecue, hot tub and plenty of lounging space with sun beds and chaise lounges. This deck also stores the tender and two PWCs aft.



The detail is found in the ambience that threads its way throughout the vessel connected by subtle elements. The open plan visually divides the aft bar from the saloon with a petrified teak and sodalite marble floor. The dining area is separated from the saloon with a low-rise credenza, effective in its task yet unobtrusive to the visual appeal of the space.





Relax in comfort and style in one of the many conversation areas. The main salon can seat a large party in the overstuffed L-shaped couch and cozy armchairs, while the skylounge offers a more intimate space. Both offer state-of-the-art entertainment and full bars that seat four guests comfortably.

The wood theme on all three decks revolves around Cherry wood with variations in the trim and insets of madrone and maple burl, bubinga, and pau ferro.

Illumination is provided by creative lighting accents in back-lit glass panels and embossed column caps. All of the custom-made accents and glasswork was accomplished in Dubai.

The graceful amidships central staircase conveniently connects all three decks.



Dine formally inside at the ten-place glass and glass dining table. *Zoom Zoom Zoom* boasts five sets of designer dinnerware.





Slumber in serenity in one of four guest cabins. Two kings and two twins with ensuite bathrooms are located off of a central foyer midships below.

An inviting master cabin with panoramic windows is located forward on the main deck. A conversation area port and an office to starboard are situated on the lower level, while the king-size bed enjoys a spectacular view from the upper level.

The his-and-hers connecting baths are accented with green-and-black verde Guatemalan marble and brown-and-beige emperador from Spain.
